First of all I would like to thank you for your support throughout this challenging second covid experience. With students returning to School we are working hard to provide further learning opportunities for them.

At Tangaroa College this means that until the end of the term (weeks 7-10) teachers will continue to provide what we like to call "blocking". Blocking means that students are expected to attend certain classes from **2.30 - 4.15pm** to be able to extend their learning, complete assessments and to seek extra support.

Additionally for the next 4 weeks we will also be providing "full day blocks" for subjects that are portfolio based or have heavy practical elements. This means students will be in their subject areas and these blocks will run from **9-4pm**.
